## Terms and conditions for the process of Conversion from Master's to Doctorate

- 1. The student may only apply for the Conversion from Master's to Doctorate within twelve (12) to eighteen (18) months of the candidature.
- 2. Candidates registered for Master's Degree programmes with at least CGPA of 3.67 at Bachelor's Degree level.
- 3. The student must submit a written report not exceeding 6,000 words regarding:
  - (i) Introduction and scope of the research;
  - (ii) Objective of the research;
  - (iii) Research methodology;
  - (iv) Research output that has been generated for the last twelve (12) to eighteen (18) months including the production of:
    - A journal paper accepted for publication and the presentation at a seminar at the national or international level; or
    - An application for patent which is pending or has been granted and a presentation at a seminar at the national or international level; or
    - Any other achievement as may be determined by the Faculty and a seminar presentation at the national or international level.
  - (v) A research plan for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy.
- 4. A panel of assessors should comprise two (2) experts from within or outside the University in the related field as may be determined by the Faculty.
- 5. The Conversion from Master's to Doctorate seminar shall as far as possible be held within a month from the date of the application for the change in the status of candidature.
